CIRCULAR TO DEPARTMENTS AND AUTHORITIES NO.1 OF 2018

PAY RATES FOR PUBLIC SECTOR TRAINEES

This Circular replaces Circular to Departments and Authorities No. 4 of 2016 – Pay Rates for Public Sector Trainees.

It provides rates of pay for trainees covered by public sector industrial instruments referring to the redundant *National Training Wage Award 2000*.

The rates of pay contained in this Circular are to be retrospectively applied from the commencement of the first pay period on or after 1 July 2017.

The *Vocational Education and Training Act 1996* (WA) requires that time spent in training and assessment is to be taken for <u>all</u> purposes as time spent working for the employer.
