CIRCULAR TO DEPARTMENTS AND AUTHORITIES NO. 22 OF 2006

STATUTORY PUBLIC HOLIDAYS FOR 2007 AND NEW YEAR 2008

Under the provisions of the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972*, the following dates are public holidays during 2007 and over the New Year period 2008.

New Year's Day

Monday 1 January 2007

Australia Day

Friday 26 January 2007

Labour Day

Monday 5 March 2007

Good Friday

Friday 6 April 2007

Easter Monday

Monday 9 April 2007

Anzac Day

Wednesday 25 April 2007

Foundation Day

Monday 4 June 2007

Queen's Birthday*

Monday 1 October 2007

Christmas Day

Tuesday 25 December 2007

Boxing Day

Wednesday 26 December 2007

New Year's Day

NOTE 1:

Easter Tuesday and the extra day adjacent to New Year's Day are no longer public service holidays. Employees, who would have otherwise received the benefit of repealed public service holidays, are able to take two days paid leave of absence in lieu of the repealed public service holidays. The two additional days paid at the rate of ordinary time, can be added to annual leave or taken individually but must be taken in the year in which they occur. Under no circumstances should these days be allowed to accrue (Please refer to Premier's Circular 1 of 2003 issued by the Department of Premier and Cabinet).

NOTE 2:

In 2008, New Year's Day falls on a Tuesday. Where, for operational reasons, it is impractical to allow employees to take a day of paid leave of absence in lieu of the repealed public service holiday on Monday 31 December 2007, arrangements to take this day in lieu during 2008 are permissible. This will not breach the intent of the Premier's Circular to ensure that days in lieu of the public service holidays are taken each year or lost.
