Circular 3 of 2024 – Superannuation on Unpaid Parental Leave

Application

1. This Circular applies to all Western Australian public sector employers.

Background

- 2. In 2021 the WA Government started providing 12 weeks of superannuation contributions on unpaid parental leave in replacement industrial agreements.
- 3. In 2023 the Government started offering 24 weeks during agreement negotiations. Several public sector occupational groups are yet to receive this enhanced condition.
- 4. On 8 March 2024 the Premier announced that all public sector employees will have administrative access to 24 weeks of superannuation on unpaid parental leave.

Instruction

- 5. All public sector employees who are on parental leave as at 1 July 2024 and any employee that commences on parental leave after this date will receive up to 24 weeks of superannuation on unpaid parental leave.
- 6. This arrangement is to be included in all replacement public sector industrial agreements.
