INDUSTRIAL EMPLOYEES' CIRCULAR NO. 8 OF 1974

SICK LEAVE WITHOUT PAY - EFFECT ON LEAVE ENTITLEMENTS.

On November 1, 1973 the Hon. Minister for Labour advised all Ministers of a Government decision that in respect to all Government salaried and wages employees, for the purpose of long service leave, annual leave and sick leave credits, where a period of sick leave without pay exceeds three months in a continuous absence, only the period in excess of three months is to be excised from qualifying service.

Applications for sick leave without pay must be supported by medical certificates or satisfactory proof of illness.

Branches of some Departments and Instrumentalities have not received this advice which should be implemented as from November 1, 1973.
