CIRCULAR TO DEPARTMENTS AND ORGANISATIONS NO. 8 OF 2018

PAY RATES FOR PUBLIC SECTOR TRAINEES

This Circular provides revised rates of pay for trainees covered by public sector industrial instruments that refer to the *National Training Wage Award 2000*.

These rates are to be applied on and from 1 July 2018.

The *Vocational Education and Training Act 1996* (WA) requires that time spent in training and assessment is to be taken for <u>all</u> purposes as time spent working for the employer.

Junior trainees undertaking an AQF Certificate IV Traineeship shall be paid an additional **3.8 per cent** loading on the hourly rate for the applicable wage level.

Full Time Adult Trainees (Weekly)

A full time adult trainee aged 21 or more years of age is entitled to **\$726.90** per week as per the *Minimum Conditions of Employment Act 1993* (WA).
