

Summary of Audits

The Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (DMIRS) contacted all government departments and agencies (agencies) regarding the risk presented by combustible cladding and requested that they undertake audits of their respective portfolios.

DMIRS requested that agencies adopt the following as a minimum audit scope:

- All buildings constructed or refurbished after 2000;
- that are three storeys or taller;
- with cladding attached or incorporate; and
- that fall within BCA classes 2, 3, 4 and 9.

Several agencies have used more robust scopes than the minimum proposed by DMIRS as an extra precaution.

\$130 million has been allocated to remediate aluminium composite cladding in the State Budget of May 2022.

This summary report will be updated on a quarterly basis.

Agency Reporting

All agencies have undertaken detailed fire engineering risk assessments for buildings that have not been cleared during the initial review. Requests for information about these should be referred to the individual government department responsible for the building.

Notes

1. All agencies with buildings within their audit scopes have engaged fire engineers to carry out a detailed risk assessment of the cladding. All reasonable measures to mitigate the risk of fire spread pending remediation have been implemented.
