REVIEW OF THE FITNESS INDUSTRY WA

Thank you for providing your Decision Regulatory Impact Statement (DRIS) on the above proposal.

The DRIS provides a useful summary of the recommendation and demonstrates justification for the proposed legislative amendments to update and expand the WA Fitness Code. The analysis indicates how the preferred option seeks to encourage consumer confidence by ensuring appropriate standards of service are maintained in an evolving industry.
