**FORMAL ADVICE ON DECISION REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT: COMPLIANT**  
*REVIEW OF MOTOR VEHICLE LEGISLATION*

Thank you for providing your Decision Regulatory Impact Statement (DRIS) on the above proposal.

The DRIS provides a useful summary of the proposed recommendations demonstrating justification for the proposed legislative amendments. The analysis indicates how the preferred options will address the necessary outcomes while also identifying reductions to red tape and regulatory burden on industry.

Based on the information provided, the Better Regulation Unit (BRU) is satisfied that the updated DRIS meets the adequacy criteria as outlined in the *Regulatory Impact Assessment Guidelines*.
