CIRCULAR TO DEPARTMENTS AND AUTHORITIES NO.19 OF 1986

POLICY ON SUBSIDISED HOUSING FOR REDEPLOYEES

The Government has approved the following policy for employees who are redeployed and who are subject to subsidised housing rental at the time of redeployment. The policy has been developed consistent with the principle that any redeployee in the public sector should not be disadvantaged through being redeployed.

1. Where an employee who is redeployed occupies subsidised accommodation which is required for the use of other employees of the owner Department, the owner Department shall continue to provide the subsidised accommodation for a period of three months from the date on which the, employee is redeployed. After that time the redeployed employee must vacate the premises.

2. Where the subsidised accommodation is not required for other employees of the owner Department, the owner Department shall continue to provide the subsidised accommodation for a period of twelve months from the date on which the employee is redeployed. At the completion of the twelve month period a commercial rent should apply.

It should be noted that the responsibility for payment of rent, and where necessary any associated costs, such as the lodgement of a bond or payment of stamp duties, is directly that of the redeployed employee.

The policy is effective from June 26, 1986 and any further advice concerning the policy should be directed to the Office of Redeployment and Retraining or this Office.
