Circular 3/2019 – District Allowance Rates

This Circular consolidates advice provided in Public Sector Labour Relations circulars 9 of 2014 and 4 of 2015.

In 2013, the State Government implemented transitional arrangements to reduce district allowance (DA) rates in the *District Allowance (Government Officers) General Agreement 2010* and the *District Allowance (Government Wages Employees) General Agreement 2010*. This process is complete.

Current DA rates for employees covered by the above industrial agreements are provided at **Schedule A**. DA is included in the calculation of superannuation guarantee contributions.
