

35. EASTER SUNDAY

35.4 Permanent and fixed term contract Employees will be provided an additional day of paid leave for Easter Sunday.

The new clause does not establish Easter Sunday as a public holiday. It simply provides a day of paid leave for Easter Sunday.

35.5 The day of paid leave will be made available to the Employee regardless of whether the Employee would normally be expected to work on that date.

35.6 The day of paid leave accrues on the date that Easter Sunday falls each calendar year.

The additional day of paid leave accrues on the date Easter Sunday falls each year. Employees who are not rostered to work on Easter Sunday are entitled to this day of paid leave.

35.7 Employee access to the day of leave is subject to the conditions set out in clause 35.2 (b)-(g).

The conditions which apply to the existing repealed public service holidays also apply to the day of paid leave for Easter Sunday.

For example, the leave day must be taken in the year in which it occurs and will be forfeited if not taken by 31 December.
