



Renewal of registration

Painting practitioner

Use of this form

This form is to be used by painters who are currently registered as practitioners with the Building Services Board and are applying for their registrations to be renewed.

Registration as a painting practitioner

In Western Australia a painter who wishes to act as a nominated supervisor for a registered painting contractor or wishes to use a prescribed title such as *registered painting practitioner* must be registered as a painting practitioner.

Registration as a painting practitioner does not authorise a person to provide services as a painting contractor.

Registration as a painting contractor

A person, partnership or company must be registered as a painting contractor to:

- contract with others to provide services as a painter with a value \$1,000 or more and is located within the area of the Board's jurisdiction; or
- use a prescribed title such as *registered painting contractor*.

Duration of registration

The renewal is for a period of three years.

Registration renewal fee

The registration renewal fee is for three years.

GST is not payable on this fee.

If the Board refuses your application the registration fee will be refunded.

Registration expiry date

You must submit your form no later than the registration expiry date.

You are encouraged to submit your form well before the expiry date. If you do not have the supporting documents, you should still submit your application form and make payment by the expiry date.

Please provide all supporting documents within 28 days of submitting this form. Your application will be finalised after receipt of the supporting documents. If you do not provide the supporting documents in 28 days, the Board may not consider your application and your registration may expire.

Late renewal of registration

If there is a reason you have not submitted your form by the expiry date you can apply for a late renewal. Should the Board agree your circumstances are exceptional they may accept your late renewal.

A fee is payable for late renewal of registration.

Instead of a late renewal you can re-apply for registration.

Australian police check

The Building Service Board must be satisfied that you are a fit and proper person to hold a painting practitioner registration.

To help assess your fitness and propriety, you must provide an Australia police check that is not more than three (3) months old at the time you lodge your application for renewal. For more information, go to:

Return of documents

The Department does not return documents. If required, make a copy before you submit your form and attachments.

After your form is submitted

If the Department requires further information, you will be contacted.

Certified copies

If you are not providing an original Australian police check, it must be a certified copy.

To have a copy certified you must show a copy of the document, together with the original document to a person who is an authorised witness. The witness must:

- certify the copy is a true copy of the original; and
- place their signature, together with their full name and their qualification to be a witness, immediately adjacent to the words of certification.

Professionals in the following occupations, who must not be related to the applicant, are authorised to certify documents:

- Accountant
- Bank Manager
- Chemist
- Dentist
- Doctor
- Justice of the Peace
- Lawyer
- Local Government Councillor
- Minister of Religion
- Police Officer
- Post Office Manager
- Public Servant
- Real Estate Agent

A complete list of authorised witnesses is available in Schedule 2 of the *Oaths, Affidavits and Statutory Declarations Act 2005*.

State Administrative Tribunal review of Board decisions

The decision to refuse an application for registration is a reviewable decision. If you disagree with the Building Services Board's determination in relation to this registration application, you may apply to the SAT for a review of the decision.
