National licensing consultation sessions

The Department of Commerce is undertaking consultation on the National Licensing Taskforce proposal to change a number of state-based occupational licences into national licences.

On 14 September 2012, the National Licensing Taskforce released the first wave of consultation drafts of legislation for reforming occupational licensing. The real estate industry is among the first wave of occupations being considered for national licensing.

As part of the consultation process, the Department is holding a series of feedback sessions in metropolitan and regional WA (please see the attached document for details).
