Transfer Duty - Lodgement, Payment and Using Revenue Online

The Office of State Revenue are running two CPD sessions for settlement agents aimed at giving licensees a general overview of transfer duty, and providing hands-on experience with the new Online Duties system. The sessions will cover examples with specific relevance to settlement agents.

- able to use the Online Duties system to lodge transactions liable for transfer duty.
