## National Licensing Taskforce information sessions

Consumer Protection would like to alert real estate agents and sales representatives to the recent release of a Commonwealth Consultation Regulation Impact Statement (CRIS) for Property Occupations.

The paper has been put together by the Commonwealth National Licensing Taskforce (Taskforce) which was set up to introduce national licences for some occupations (electrical, property occupations, plumbing and gasfitting and refrigeration and air-conditioning as a first step).
