

Key Outcomes of the WA Building and Construction Consultative Committee (BCC Committee) meeting

Held on 9 March 2023

- The third meeting of the BCC Committee commenced with an acknowledgement of country and the Chair welcoming Mr Matt Swinbourn, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industrial Relations; Mr Murray Thomas representing the Master Plumbers and Gasfitters Association, and other members and invited guests.
- The Chair thanked all members for participating in one-on-one discussions in preceding weeks with Australian Venture Consultants (AVC) to further identify priority issues and areas of focus to be included in the BCC Committee Strategic Plan.
- AVC led a workshop to:
 - finalise the priorities framework which sets out the specific issues for the BCC Committee's focus in its first two years of operation;
 - > set the objectives for each of those priority areas of focus; and
 - > establish a program of work over the next 18 months in pursuit of those objectives.
- Significant progress was made with a further meeting being held on 30 March 2023 to finalise discussions on priority areas that were not covered in this session.
