

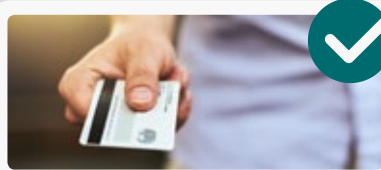


Buying or selling motor vehicles? You may need a licence!

Follow these simple steps



Choose the category of licence that is right for you and apply



Pay the correct licensing fees when they're due



Start being a motor vehicle dealer



Learn

Attend a relevant training course at an accepted training provider to ensure you know your obligations under the law.



Choose

Choose the correct licence category/ies for the types of vehicles you plan to deal in or sell.



Specify

Let us know where you propose to run your business.



Register

If applicable, [register your business name and/or company with ASIC](#).



Apply

Fill out the correct [application form](#) for your circumstances, making sure you indicate the licence category/ies you have chosen.



Provide

Provide a [national police certificate](#) that is less than three months old, for each individual in the application.



Pay

Pay the appropriate [fee](#).



We check

Consumer Protection will check your credit history to make sure you can support the type of licence you apply for.
