In order to lawfully sell vehicles on consignment, a dealer must apply to the Commissioner for Consumer Protection the removal of the condition prohibiting consignment selling. Before removing the condition, the Commissioner must be satisfied that the licensee has sufficient financial resources. To assist the Commissioner in making that decision, a current assessment must be undertaken of the dealership's continued financial viability. To enable this assessment, please complete this form. You must ensure that the Authorisation and Declaration on page 2 is signed by all directors, partners (or directors of any corporate partners), or the sole trader.
